19/01	APOLOGIES There were no apologies.
19/02	MINUTES The minutes of the Meeting of the Council 19 th March 2019 were received and approved.
	The meeting was adjourned the meeting for up to 15 minutes to take questions or comments through the Chairman from members of the public. There were 5 members of the public present. One member of the public gave a report about the proposed dog agility area. One member of the public requested that no further action be taken in Millfields. One member of the public asked about parking in the Market Place and if any action was being taken to improve it. The Chairman explained that the work being undertaken at Millfields was agreed following positive feedback from the comprehensive public consultation exercise. The Chairman explained that several meetings had taken place with interested parties including Hambleton District Council and NYCC and that the matter of car parking was being progressed. A member of the public requested that the news section on the website should be updated with local events. A member of the public asked about the proposed Park Run and where parking would take place, the Chairman explained that parking would not be allowed on the rough grassland area. Councillor Knapton explained that details of parking locations in the Town (e.g. Millfields car parks and town centre etc.) would be notified to participants to avoid any parking disruption. He also explained that the event would be appropriately marshalled and only last an hour from 9-10am on a Saturday.
