<b>1.</b>	<b>Apologies</b> Apologies were received from co-opted member Di Watkins.
<b>2.</b>	<b>Public Questions or Comments</b> It was resolved to adjourn the meeting for up to 15 minutes to take questions or comments through the Chairman from members of the public. There were no members of the public present and no questions were asked.

<b>4.</b>	<b>Easingwold Youth Forum</b> An update was received from Councillor Gledhill and it was <b>RESOLVED</b> to continue the Youth Forum with more regular meetings.
<b>5.</b>	<b>Summer Entertainment in the Market Place</b> An update was received from Councillor Johnston-Banks and it was <b>RESOLVED</b> to continue to move the item forward where possible. It was <b>AGREED</b> that the Clerk would check the music licence requirements and investigate available budgets. Councillor Johnston-Banks will progress this item with the business forum and the Vibrant Market Towns team when they become available.
<b>6.</b>	<b>Litter Hero Proposal</b> A proposal was received from Councillor Gledhill to set up a group of litter heroes, regularly incorporating social activities into litter picking. It was <b>AGREED</b> that Councillor Gledhill would link up with the green spaces group to move the item forward.
<b>7.</b>	<b>Wi-fi usage</b> The quarterly report was received, and it was <b>AGREED</b> to put the item on the next agenda.
<b>8.</b>	<b>Easingwold In Bloom</b> The arrangements and the judge were confirmed for summer 2020. If any councillors see any displays worth considering in the town, please could they send a photo to the Clerk who will forward it to the judge.
<b>9.</b>	<b>Christmas Events</b> It was <b>AGREED</b> to continue with Light Up A Life (25 <sup>th</sup> November), the Christmas Market (5 <sup>th</sup> December), Lions Carols in the Market Place, Trees on the Green, Easingwold in Lights, Christmas Commercial Lights window display, the Christmas Windows trail, potentially the Toy Run and to continue to try to ensure that NYCC adapt the lamp posts to enable Christmas lights on Long Street.
