- The rugby posts have been removed by Chris Jackson after they were deemed unsafe by the manufacturers
- Essential repairs to equipment at the Memorial Park will be carried out following quarterly inspection reports.
- Phoenix Trees have submitted an application to HDC for work to be carried out at Mallison Woods and are meeting with a Planning Officer to carry out a site visit.
