1.	Apologies Apologies were received from Councillors Tanfield and Gledhill and Di Watkins.
2.	Public Questions or Comments It was resolved to adjourn the meeting for up to 15 minutes to take questions or comments through the Chairman from members of the public. There were no members of the public present and therefore no questions were asked.
3.	Action Plan The action plan for Social & Events and it was resolved to review any developments for the friendship tea for the new council.
4.	Easingwold Youth Council An An update was received from Councillor Barnes regarding the bench placement.
5.	Entertainment in the Market Place An update was received from Councillor Johnston-Banks. It was agreed that the Town Band should receive £200 from the donation budget and £100 from the Summer of Music budget. It was AGREED that the Clerk should inform the Town Band that it is safe to play in the bandstand. It was AGREED to add the date of the Town Band Memorial Park performance to the summer of music schedule.

Digital Activities 6.1 The provision of Wifi in the town centre was considered and, in light of the installation of North Yorkshire Wifi, it was AGREED to cancel the existing Wi-Fi as the equipment and the wayleave agreements require updating. The Clerk is investigating with NYCC whether its WiFi provision can be extended to the other side of the marketplace It was AGREED to review arrangements in June at the next Social & Events committee meeting. 6.2 Digital impact - The google analytics report was received.

8.	Queens Platinum Jubilee celebrations A costed proposal was received, and it was AGREED to allocate a budget of £1,500 to the project.
9.	Budget The financial position at the end of February 2022 was noted and no virements were considered necessary.
10.	Summer Planting It was RESOLVED to select red, white & blue to emphasise the town's support for the Queen's Platinum Jubilee.
