25/155	MINUTES The minutes of the meeting of the Council of 16 th December 2025 were received and approved.
25/156	CLERK'S PROGRESS REPORT <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • An email was sent to the Inspector regarding policing in Easingwold and he has confirmed that there will be staff in place by March • The Clerk has spoken to NYC regarding CCTV and is arranging a meeting with interested councillors and a representative of NYC • Welcoms has confirmed closure of the account • A skip has been arranged for the Miscellaneous Works Contractor's allotment • An email was sent to M E Willis to approve the quote for a new lawnmower for £749 • An email was sent to the Furry Tails Dog Training company to refuse the request to use Millfields for commercial enterprise, but alternative solutions were offered • The fence contractor has amended all the outstanding issues at Claypenny playground • The Clerk has been in contact with the Hesley Group regarding the path in Millfields and has received an interim response with commitment to responding to the specific questions • The precept request has been sent to NYC, along with a breakdown of the budget and an acknowledgement received • The Easingwold 10k road race request to be held on 26th May 2026 by the running club was approved under delegated authority by the Chairman
25/157	NORTH YORKSHIRE POLICE No update was received from North Yorkshire Police.
25/158	ACTION PLAN The action plan was received and updated.
25/159	NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNCIL An update was received from County Councillor Knapton. Revised NYC boundary proposals will be laid before parliament that will create an Easingwold and Stillington Ward. Revised bus stop proposals in the Market Place are being considered. The installation of a bus shelter on Long Street is being considered. There is no further progress on the EV project in the Galtres rear car park. The Redrow & Linden path has been inspected by a new officer and is being moved forward. Councillor Bilson asked why Easingwold did not qualify for a bleed pack and Councillor Knapton agreed to investigate the reason.
25/160	SUSTRANS BENCH Quotes were received for a replacement bench and it was RESOLVED to approve the Oak & Rope teak bench. It was AGREED to remeasure the site to ensure the correct sized bench is ordered.
